Introduction:

Coaches and volunteers are not expected to be safeguarding experts, but rather to know how to implement best practice and how to respond to a concern.

The required SG1 training is based on Sport Ireland and Sport Northern Ireland guidance documents and related legislation. On completion of all 3 safeguarding modules those working with age-grade players will be able to create a playercentred environment, implement best practice, identify concerns and know how to respond appropriately to those concerns.

Once you have completed the safeguarding award, support is available on an ongoing basis to maintain safeguarding standards through your Club Welfare Officer and your provincial Spirit of Rugby Officer.



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
STEP 3: click proceed button
